PANDEMIC RELATED INFORMATION: COVID-19

2022 is currently still an unknown to us all. Nobody knows when and how this pandemic will come to an end and when life will finally return to normal. It is with this in mind that we would like to bring the following to your attention.

3RC will comply with all health-related restrictions and measures in place by government at any given stage during 2022. We guarantee full compliance by our staff and our client representatives. The impact of this might influence the size and length of any given show and therefore we ask our schools to be flexible with us during this incredibly challenging time.

Where required we can do two shows dividing the matric group in two to avoid overcrowding and making sure that we comply with all regulations. This will mean shorter interactions with the learners, but we need to put their safety first.

In the event of an outbreak at your school that leads to the show being cancelled, we will automatically move your school onto our Virtual Portal and you will receive a Marketing Box with collateral from all the presenting colleges and companies that would have exhibited at your Career Day. You will also receive a manual on how to use the Virtual Portal as part of your LO- Career Guidance lessons. It will be your responsibility to ensure all matrics register on the Virtual Portal.

3RC is taking Career Guidance and Career EXPO's to the next level and we invite you to join us.

1. We require that all learners **register for the event no less than 3 days before the event is due to happen at your school**. We will send you a web link to share with the students and their parents. Registration is crucial as this guarantees compliance with the updated POPI act to which we subscribe.
* Written consent is required if the learner is not able to register online.
2. If learners are not able to register online we would require the responsible teacher to send out the consent form to the parents and learners before the event. 3RC will supply this to the school once your booking has been confirmed. All physical consent forms (for those learners that could not register online) should be handed to the 3RC staff on the day of the expo
3. Cancellation of your booking **4 weeks prior** to the date that has been confirmed in writing will be seen as a breach of this contract and your school will be charged a cancellation fee of R8 000 ex VAT.
This excludes any cancellation due to COVID-19 or the closure of your school due to a health risk.
4. A school may only change the date which has been confirmed in writing 4 weeks prior to the confirmed date, please understand that due to logistical procedures we cannot change dates less than 4 weeks prior to the show.
5. **ALL** grade 12 learners must attend the expo, please bear this in mind when selecting a date.
* Grade 11's are optional depending on the size of the group.
6. The venue where the RockingFuture is to be held should be cleaned and there should be 26 tables or school desks (depending on the size of the hall) arranged in a U shape around the hall (see attached diagram). Please make sure there are 2 chairs per exhibitor stand. The stage should be cleared. Depending on the size of the group you can put out chairs for the learners to sit on or let them sit on the floor. Please ensure the floor is clean if they will be sitting on the floor.
*** A stand can be 1 steel trestle table or two school desks pushed together. We rely on your guidance to ensure social distancing and the space between stands.**
7. The contact teacher will inform all relevant parties including but not limited to the Head of Department, Matric teachers, school principal, ground staff, security members, secretarial staff and parents (should learners be leaving the school) that learners will be attending the **RockingFuture** on the date confirmed in writing.

8. **RockingFuture** requires a minimum of 90 minutes* with your Grade 12 learners and preferably the entire 120min as indicated on the brochure. Please keep this in mind when selecting a date and time. We cannot allow learners to leave midway through the expo, all Grade 12 learners are required to stay for the entire expo.

** A group of more than 100 learners need the full 2 hours.*

9. The expo/show has interactive parts where we ask learners to communicate with us on social media platforms. We ask that you inform your learners of this and allow them to bring their cell phones into the expo during those 2 hours that you have booked.

10. The cancellation fee has been put into place because of the following: Although the show is offered to your school free of charge it does cost 3RC a great deal to stage this expo. This cost is made up of transport, technical equipment rental, branding, printing of the free **FutureGuide** magazine and administration costs.

11. These costs are offset by the fact that the exhibitors pay a fee to attend the show with the promise that they will see your school and the number of learners as indicated on your completed booking form. When a school cancels 3RC refunds the exhibitors the cost of exhibiting if we can not replace it with another school. It is for this reason that we ask that you do not cancel your booking 4 weeks prior to the show

12. The school takes responsibility as guardians for all learners attending the RockingFuture career expo. Any and all data **VOLUNTEERED** by the learners will be used by the attending institutions as well as 3RC for marketing purposes. This data will not be abused or sold to parties not attending the RockingFuture career expo.

By signing this document, you acknowledge that you have read and understood the Terms and Conditions of booking a slot on the RockingFuture and that this document becomes legal and binding upon receipt by 3RC. Your booking will be confirmed in writing within 24 hours after receiving this document return via fax or email. If you have not received confirmation within the given 24 hours, please contact our office to follow up on this.
